



# TEXTURED BAG

## SIZE

One size

## TENSION

10 stitches and 11 rows to 10cm/4in  
Measured over pattern using 10mm  
(US 15) needles

## BASE

Using 10mm (US 15) needles cast on 2 stitches.

**Next Row:** Knit into the front and back of both stitches. 4 stitches.

**Next Row:** Knit into the front and back of next stitch, working in purl 1, knit 1, moss stitch work to last stitch, knitting in the front and back of last stitch. 6 stitches.

Working increases as set above and keeping moss stitch pattern correct throughout, taking increases into pattern.

Increase one stitch at each end of every row to 46 stitches.

Place a stitch marker at each end of last row.

## SIDES – MAKE 4

### SIDE PANEL

**Row 1:** Pattern to end.

**Row 2:** Pattern to end.

**Row 3:** \* Purl 1, with yarn at front of work slip next stitch knitwise repeat from \*to last stitch, knit 1.

**Row 4:** Pattern to end.

Repeat rows 3 and 4, 19 times more.

Work 3 rows in moss stitch.

Cast off.

## MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page (see page 140).

Join each panel; starting at the cast on edge, join each panel using mattress stitch, using markers as a guide to match up corners, repeat for remaining 3 seams.

Attach 2 handles of your choice approximately on opposites sides 5cm/2in down from the cast on edge on the wrong side of your bag.
