



1 Cut one of the tubes in half across the middle and discard one of the halves.



2 Squash and fold the half tube into an hourglass shape.



3 Glue the short tube between the two remaining tubes, roughly $\frac{1}{2}$ in (1cm) from one end. At the other end add a dab of glue and press the two tubes together.



4 Paint the binoculars in bright festive colors and leave to dry. You may need a few coats to get an even coverage.



5 Decorate your tubes however you like. These ones have been embellished with pom-poms and rickrack.



6 Use a pair of scissors to make a small hole $\frac{1}{2}$ in (1cm) down from the top on each of the outer sides of the tubes at the narrower end of the binoculars. Push the brad pin through the hole, then pop the ribbon onto the point and open it out to secure.



7 Repeat on the other side and get Santa spotting.
